Windy Point Park on Lake Travis in Austin is the most popular dive training site. We frequent this park because of the safety restrictions (no boats, jet-skis, fishing, or pets allowed) and amenities offered (training platforms, picnic tables, air fill station, camp sites). Scuba park fees are \$15 per person per day, \$6 for an air fill, and \$10 per person if choosing to camp overnight.

Your instructor may discuss alternative dive training sites: Athens Scuba Park, Comal River, Balmorhea State Park, Cozumel, etc. Weather, temperature, visibility, student comfort, and skills are determining factors your instructor will consider.

C&J Divers Scuba does not provide transportation to the open water dive site.
